



Arabian and Half-Arabian Futurity Rules

General Provisions

The Futurity is open to horses produced by mares that are owned or leased by adult ODAHA members in good standing at the time of nomination. Members in good standing are those members who have kept their ODAHA memberships current and have no outstanding debts of any kind to ODAHA.

Horses entered in the ODAHA Futurity may be shown in halter as one, two and three year olds. Performance classes will be held for three and four year olds.

Nomination of Dam

Any adult member of ODAHA who is in good standing may nominate mares whose foals are eligible for registration with the ARABIAN HORSE ASSOCIATION. Mares must be nominated no later than January 10th of the year in which the foal is born in order for the resulting foal to be eligible to participate in the ODAHA Futurity. Nominations must be on the correct form and accompanied by \$10.00 and proof of ownership or lease.

Renomination of Foal

Each foal of a properly nominated mare is to be renominated by paying a \$30.00 renomination fee no later than August 15th of the year in which the foal is born.

One, Two and Three Year Old Halter Horses

Renominations of eligible horses must be made no later than March 15th for each year that the horse is eligible to participate in the futurity. The renomination fee is \$30.00 per year. A copy of the horse's registration papers must be included with the yearling payment.

Three and Four Year Old Performance Horses

Eligible performance horses need not have made any halter payments but shall pay a performance fee of \$30.00 per division entered. Divisions offered will be English Pleasure, Western Pleasure, Hunter Pleasure. Entries will be shown and judged under current International Arabian Horse Association and USA Equestrian rules.

Jackpot

To participate in the jackpot, a fee of \$20.00 must be paid with the nomination of dam for yearlings and with the renomination for older horses. The entire jackpot for each class will be awarded to the highest placing horse who is participating in the jackpot.

Prize Money

Nomination of dam fees and weanling payments will be set aside and paid out as follows: Expenses will be deducted from mare nomination funds and any remaining funds will be paid out in the yearling year. Weanling nomination payments will be paid out in the yearling year. Paybacks will be divided into proportionately according to gender of nominated horses in each year. Nomination fees paid during the yearling and two-year-old years will be divided proportionately according to the gender of the foal nominated. Prize money in each class will be distributed among the first 5 place horses as follows: 1st-30%, 2nd-25%, 3rd-20%, 4th-15%, 5th-10%. If less than 5 horses are shown, the remaining money will be awarded proportionately among those present.

4 horses: 1st-33%, 2nd-28%, 3rd-22%, 4th-17%

3 horses: 1st-40%, 2nd-33%, 3rd-27%

2 horses: 1st-55%, 2nd-45%

1 horse: 1st-100%

Payouts will be given at the show or must be paid within 30 days of Futurity show date.

Payments

Renomination payments not postmarked on or before the due date will be accepted only with a \$15.00 late fee per missed payment. Futurity fees are not refundable. Foals which die within 30 days of foaling, accompanied by a veterinarian's certificate may have their fees credited to a subsequent years foal. All payments should be made payable to "ODAHA Futurity." Timely payments are the responsibility of the futurity participant.

Change of Address/Sale of Horse

It is the responsibility of the owner of a Futurity eligible horse to notify the Futurity Secretary of a change of address in writing. If a Futurity eligible horse is sold, it becomes the responsibility of the new owner to inform the Futurity Secretary in writing of the change of ownership and the new owner's address. A copy of the horse's registration papers in the new owner's name must be included. In order to maintain eligibility the new owner shall keep up all renominations, including late fees.

Special Exceptions

From time to time, horses are donated to the ODAHA Futurity to be sold. Donated horses shall be granted entry into the Futurity without having been properly nominated, provided said horse is of age and breed to be granted entry. Purchaser is responsible for all payments on said horse beyond entry granted. Yearling donations shall not be eligible to participate in yearling jackpot. Proceeds of sale of donated horse shall first cover any expenses incurred by Futurity for the sale of the horse, all remaining funds shall be divided primarily among the two, three and four year old classes.

Administration

The ODAHA Futurity will be administered by a committee appointed by the ODAHA President. Any disputes shall be resolved by the ODAHA Board of Directors.
